STATUTE: ANN. STAT. § 14-11-102

DETAILS

What are the age restrictions?

The infant must be sixty (60) days old or younger.

Who can relinquish the infant?

An unharmed newborn may be anonymously relinquished by the parent or designee and did not express an intent to return for the child.

Who are Wyoming Safe Haven Providers?

- Any on-duty staff member at a 24/7 staffed location:
 - Fire Station
 - Hospital
 - Police Department or Sheriff's Office

Is there anything else need to know?

- Infant must be directly handed to provider, if there are no staff available at a specific location please call 1-888-510-2229 for help.
 - Provider to ask if the infant has any tribal affiliation or Native American ancestry and if so, the WY ICWA protocol must be followed.
 - Provider to notify Child Protective Services within 24 hours.
