# SAFE HAVEN

The VA Safe Haven Law allows a parent to safely surrender their unharmed infant up to 30 days old or younger to a staff member at a hospital that provides 24-hour emergency services, an attended Emergency Medical Services (EMS) agency that employs emergency medical personnel such as some fire stations or rescue squads, or a newborn safety device located at and operated by such hospital or emergency medical services
